## There are 5 obligatory prayers :

Fajr Prayer (Dawn) -from the 2nd dawn until sunrise. 2 Rak'ah (unit of prayer)

Dhuhr Prayer (Noon)- from the sun passing the meridian until an object's shadow is equal to its length plus its lenght at meridian 4 Rak'ah (unit of prayer)

Asr Prayer (Afternoon) - from the end of Dhuhr time until the sun begins to turn yellow. 4 Rak'ah (unit of prayer)

Maghrib prayer (After sunset) from sunset until the 3 Rak'ah (unit of prayer) disappearance of the twilight.

> *Ishā*' prayer (Night) from the end of *Maghrib* prayer until the middle of the night. 4 Rak'ah (unit of prayer)

# My Five Daily Prayers



Intention : Have an intention to pray immediately prior to the prayer in your Heart (not spoken)

Face Qiblah (Ka'bah) & raise your hand & say Takbeeratul Ihrãm "Allāhu Akbar" to start 1<sup>st</sup> "Rak'ah"

You are required to look at the place of prostration From the beginning of the prayer until the end Allāhu Akbar (Allāh is the Greatest) Put your hands crossed on your chest (right above left) as shown & start reciting "Al Fateha" + other Verses of Qur'an (last page)
